There have been a few minor changes made to the AMIS Plus Questionnaire. This slightly revised questionnaire will be in operation from August 1, 2007.


New email address for the AMIS Plus Data Center

Last but not least, we welcome all new AMIS Plus participants who have recently joined the project and look forward to our collaboration. Enjoy the warm season and have a great summer!


