AMIS Plus at the World Congress of Cardiology 2006

As many as six abstracts from AMIS Plus were presented at the World Congress of Cardiology from September 2-6 in Barcelona, Spain.

One of the main topics discussed at the Congress was that of elderly patients. AMIS Plus registry provided important information on clinical presentation, treatment and outcome regarding patients above the age of 80. Elderly patients are less likely to present with classic chest pain, but more often show dyspnea and other symptoms of heart failure. Furthermore, they are contemporary less likely to receive reperfusion therapy, which probably contributes to a worse outcome in this growing population. Considering the favourable outcome, treatment decisions regarding elderly patients with acute coronary syndrome should be individualized and directed by comorbidities rather than by age alone.
