AMIS Plus at the Swiss Society of Cardiology Congress 2006

Five abstracts from AMIS Plus were presented at the SSC Congress in Basle.



We were shown how AMIS Plus data could be used for the development of a novel risk stratification model, new results of the impact of clopidogrel on major adverse cardiac events, the role of age and gender as well as incidence and prognostic significance of atrial fibrillation in patients with acute coronary syndrome. AMIS Plus results were also published in the Revue Medical Suisse. A.-A. Fassa et al: Temporal trends in treatment of ST segment elevation myocardial infarction in Switzerland from 1997 to 2005. Rev Med Suisse 2006; 2; 1393-8.

AMIS Plus Follow-up

The AMIS Plus database is rapidly growing. At the moment we have already 1269 patients with 3-month and 418 patients with 12-month follow up after the cardiac event.
