
Dear AMIS Plus Participants & Sponsors

Activities have been a little slow in these recent corona years but now AMIS Plus is back on track with 5 presentations at the Swiss Society of Cardiology Congress. The following topics were presented:

- Acute myocardial infarction and work inability: insights from the AMIS Plus Registry
- Bradycardia and acute coronary syndromes: analysis on outcomes on 51001 patients enrolled in the Acute Myocardial Infarction in Switzerland Registry
- 20-year trends in the prevalence of cardiovascular risk factors and outcomes among young adults (<50 years old) hospitalized with acute coronary syndromes in Switzerland
