Status Quo

A recent AMIS Plus collaboration with two other cardiology registries, namely SPUM (Swiss) and MINAP - the largest UK registry led to the development of the new GRACE3 score resulting in a publication in Lancet (see enclosed).

Furthermore, an anniversary project is planned to incorporate mortality data from the last 10 years into the registry. Further innovations will be tested to increase the value of our database.
